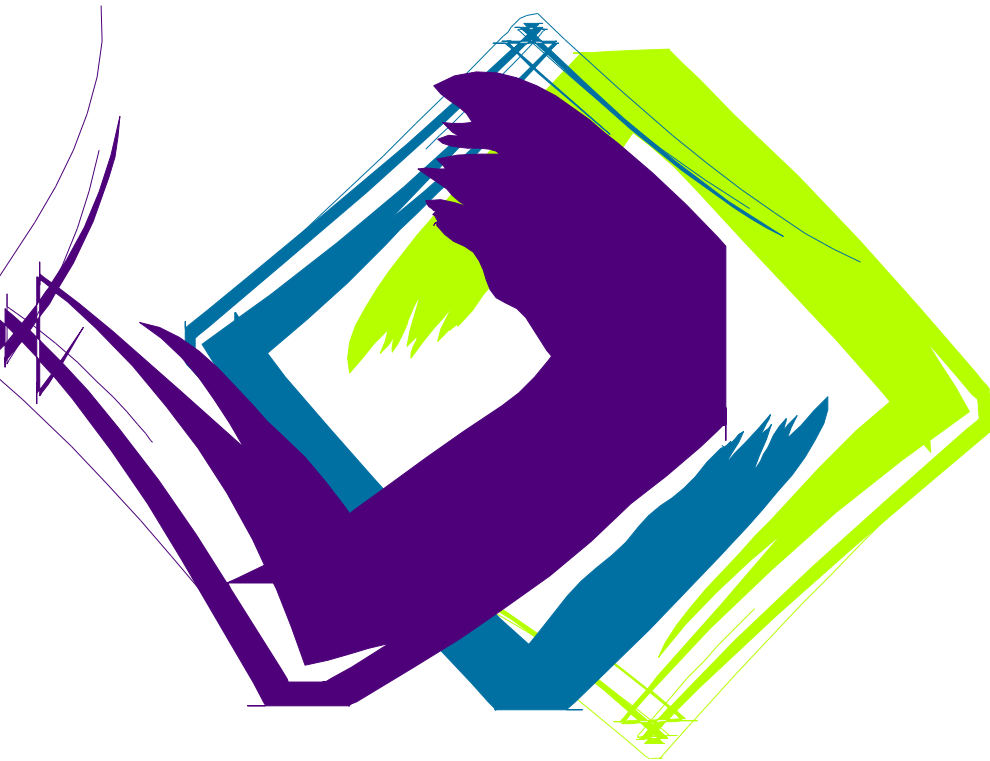

book club sets

what is a book club set?

A Book Club Set is a bag containing 10 copies of the same title and a book club information folder. The folder includes book reviews, an author biography and discussion questions to use at your meeting. We also provide a sign out sheet for your members to use and tips on running a book club meeting. Some sets also include an audiobook and /or large print copy of the title.

how to borrow them

Someone in your book club must have an active Library card and take responsibility for the Book Club Set.

Book Club Sets are kept at the lower level customer service desk and have a six-week loan period (no renewals). You may have up to two sets signed out at a time.

Book Club Sets cannot be placed on hold through our online catalogue. Please visit, call or email the Library to reserve a set. We recommend that you reserve your selection a few months in advance to ensure availability.

how to return them

The entire set must be returned at the same time (all copies of the title, the information folder and the bag). It must be returned to the customer service desk, not through the book drop. Late fees are \$2.00 per day.

how to join a library book club

Brockville Public Library operates many monthly book clubs, ask any staff member about joining one of the groups.
